

# Proposed change to Service Priority – Communities and Support

# 1 Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to bring to the Cabinet's attention a recommendation from the Performance Review and Scrutiny Committee, that the Cabinet reverse its decision to revise the target in respect the percentage of PPP maintenance issues that are addressed within timescale, from 100% to 90%.

# 2 Background

- 2.1 The Cabinet on 27 August 2013 adopted the recommendation that the target percentage of PPP maintenance issues that are addressed within timescale be reduced from 100% to 90%. The recommendation was based on the fact that it is unrealistic to have a target of 100% as there will always be unexpected issues that will result in downtime.
- 2.2 The Performance Review and Scrutiny Committee, whilst accepting that downtime situations will arise, saw no benefit to the Council in reducing the target and felt that maintaining the target at 100% accorded with the service priority in ensuring that children had the best start in life by focusing on prevention and early intervention to address barriers to progress and to deliver effective outcomes. The Committee also noted that the Council was on target in the current year to achieve the 100% target. The Committee accordingly recommended that the Cabinet reverse its decision of 27 August 2013 and reinstate the 100% target.
