The Scottish Conservative Group hereby make the following Motion for consideration by the Council on 7 November 2017 –

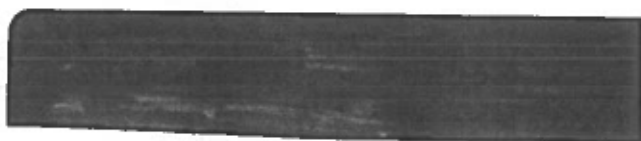
