(g) To note the improvement in attainment levels across Midlothian Schools;

(h) To note that the increased pupil population due to new housing developments was putting pressure on accommodation in a number of Primary Schools;

(i) To note the rebalancing of care for older people, including a national award;

(j) To note the measures in place to address the managing of stress and absence within the Adult and Community Care service;

(k) Agreed that consideration be given to expanding the use of the Internet within Libraries; and

(I) To note that a report on the School Estate Plan would be submitted to Council.
